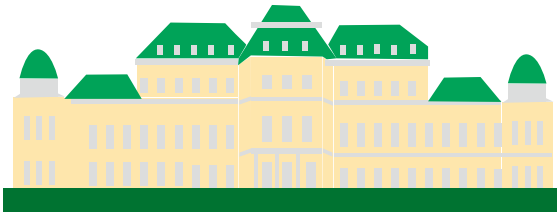


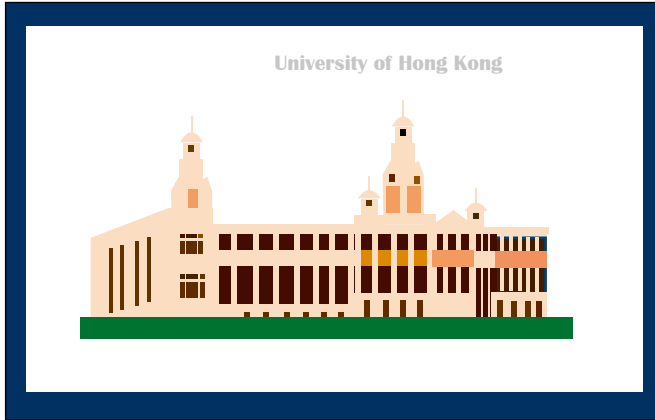

Tel Aviv University, or TAU



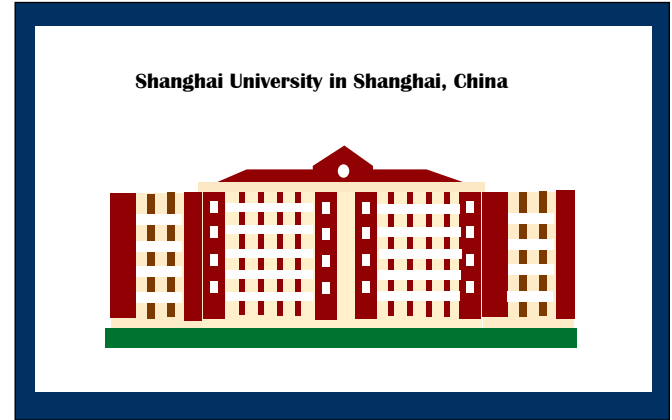

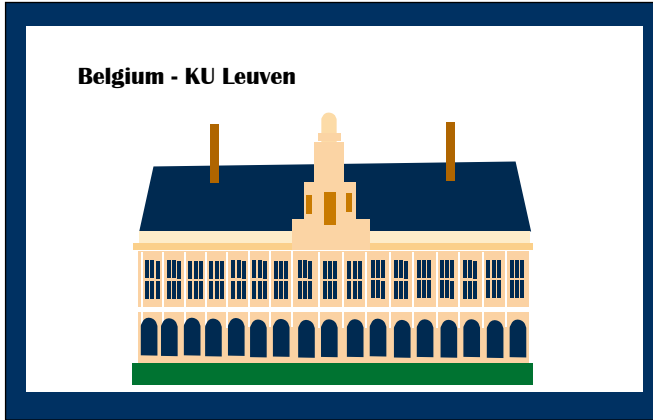

French-speaking moved to New Leuven to establish the French Catholic University of Leuven.

The university was officially recognized by King Philip II and Pope Innocent III in 1200 and 1215 respectively. In 1257, the first college institution of the university, Sorbonne College, was established, and Sorbonne became the university's representative. In 1793, at the height of the French Revolution, the University of Paris was disbanded. Rebuilt in 1896.

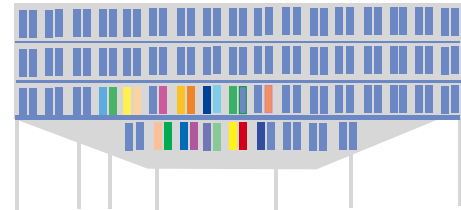
The Hong Kong University of

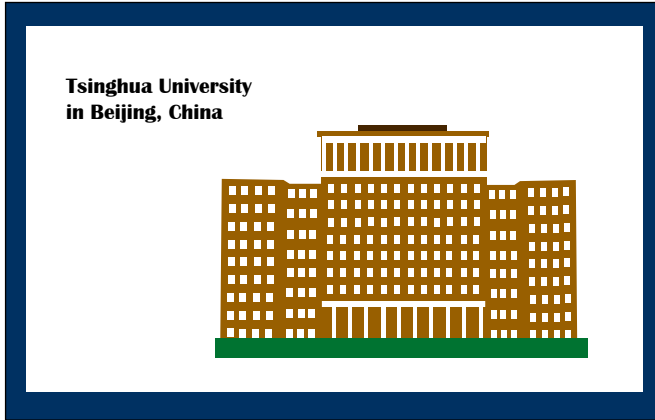

University of Southern Denmark



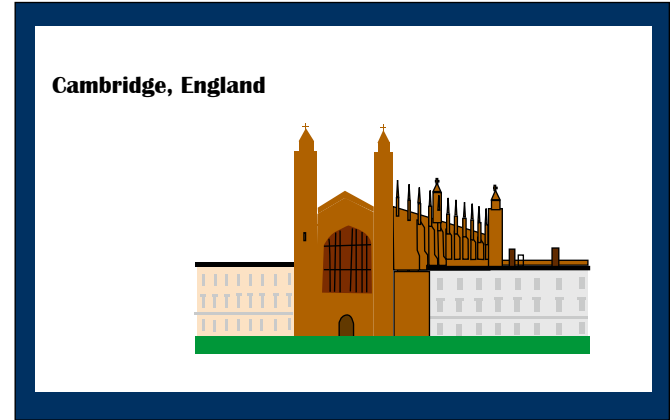

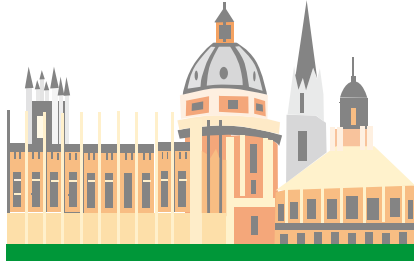

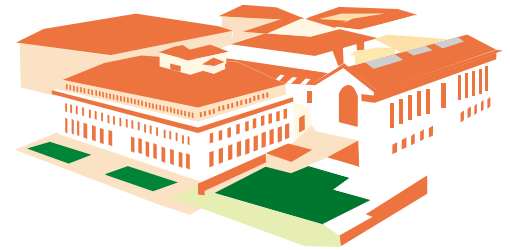
University of Oxford, United Kingdom

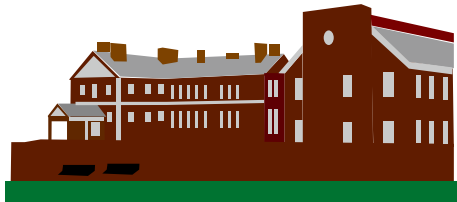
Berkeley University of California

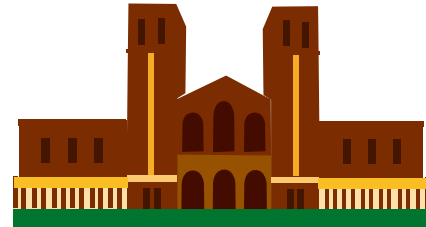

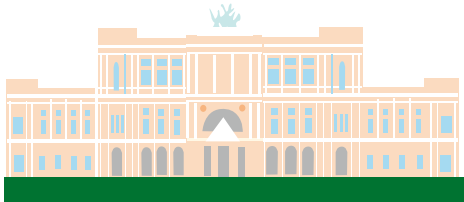
Los Angeles, California, USA

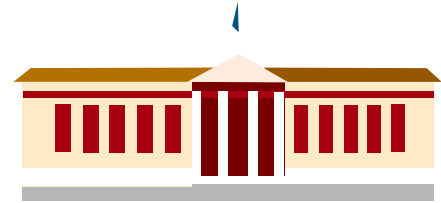
University of Roma 'La Sapienza', Italy

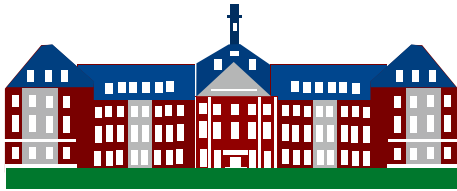
National and Kapodistrian University of Athens

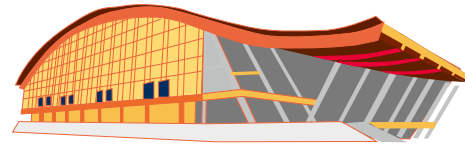
Baltimore, Maryland, USA

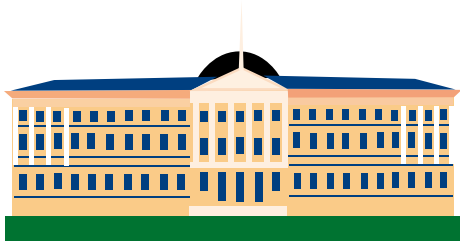
Nanyang Technological University, Singapore

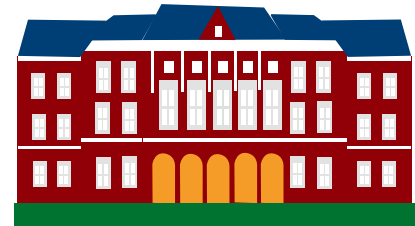

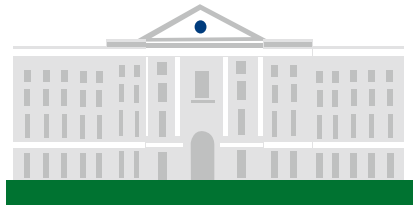
UNIGIS Poland – Jagiellonian University

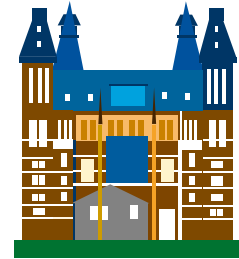
Trinity University College Dublin

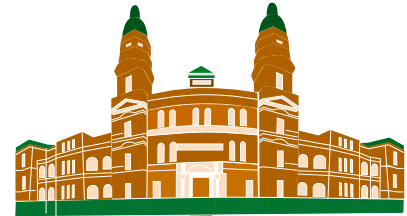
University of Oslo, Norway

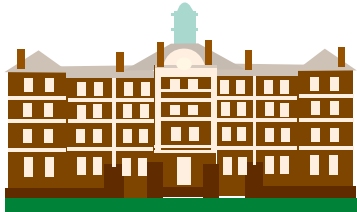

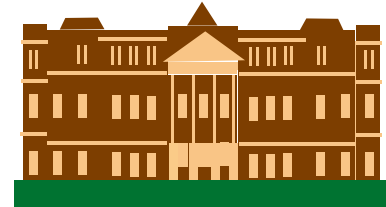
Imperial College London, United Kingdom

Universidad de Buenos Aires (Argentina)



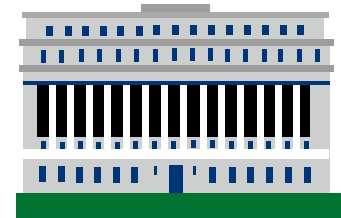

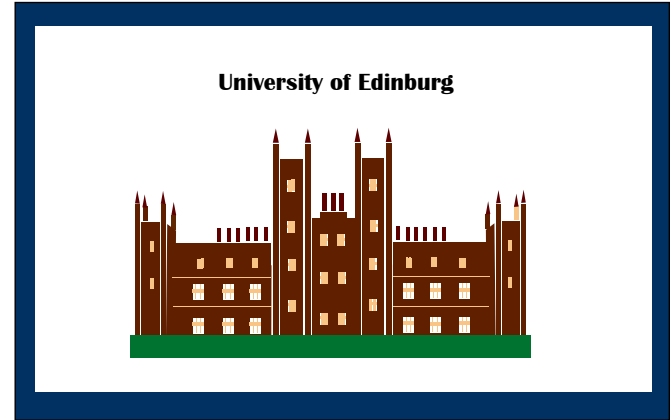
The University of Bucharest, a university in Bucharest, Romania, was founded in 1864. University of Bucharest has 34,000 students

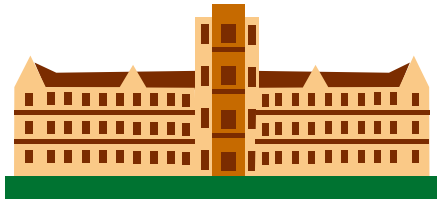

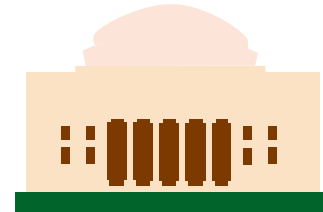

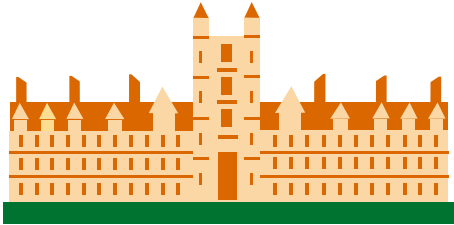
Massachusetts Institute of Technology

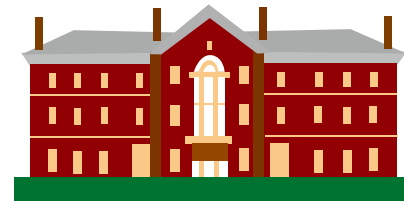
University of Michigan

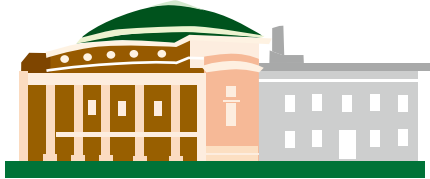
Brown University

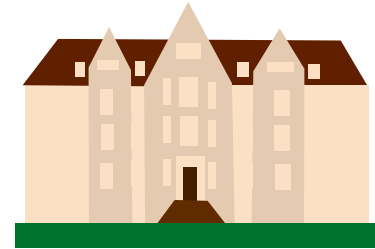
University of Toronto

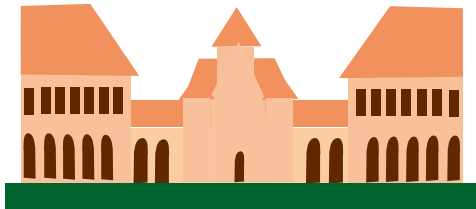
University of Chicago, U.S.A.

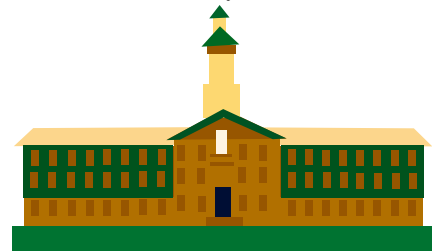
Stanford University, United States of America

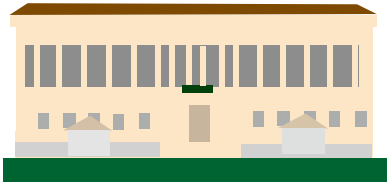
Princeton University, U.S.A.

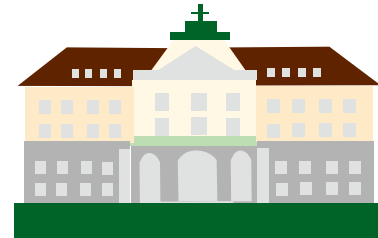
California Institute of Technology, U.S.A.

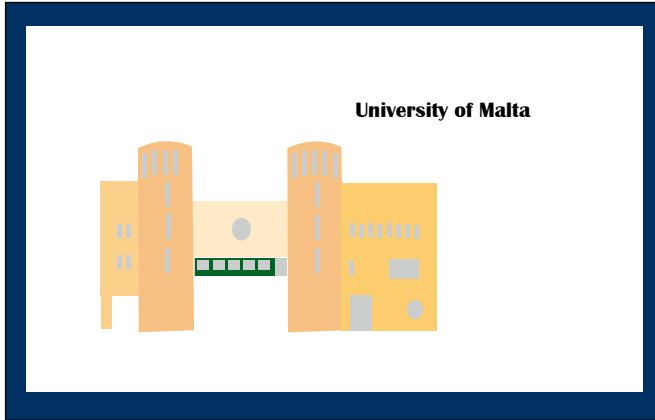

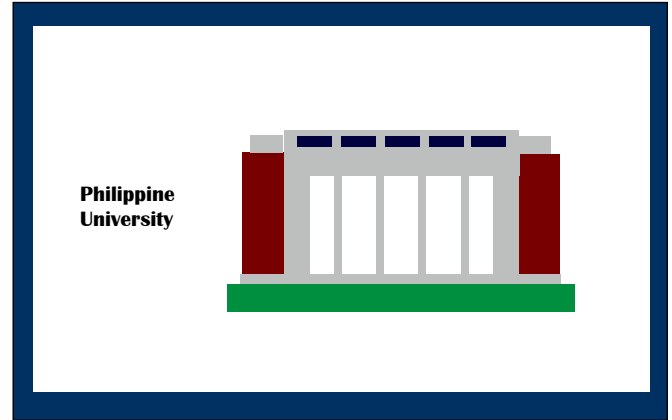
The University of Ljubljana is a university located in Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia. It is the oldest and largest university in Slovenia.

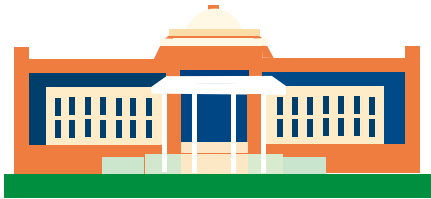

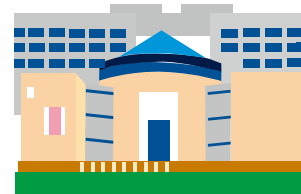
University of Iceland

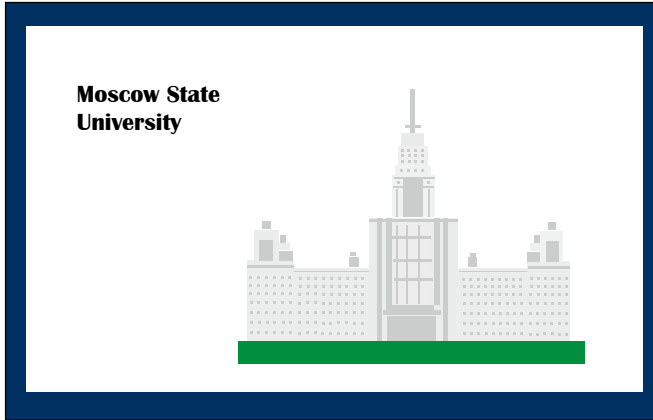

YORK University



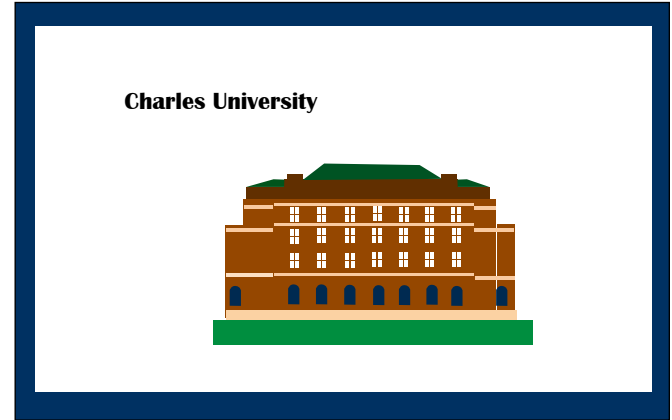
